Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are all well and have managed to keep warm over the past few days. I am writing to inform you that we have cleared a significant amount of snow to make clear pathways into the building and the office. Therefore, unless there is a significant change in the weather, we will be open tomorrow with a few conditions that I would ask you to read carefully.

- The school is safe to be open to all year groups.
- Main reception will be open from 9.45am for pupils to enter the school. This is the only access to the building.
- There will be no breakfast club.
- World Book day will be postponed to enable children to wrap up warm, including weather appropriate footwear. The new date will be announced in our newsletter.
- There will be no school led before school or after school clubs.
- Avengers will not be running.
- Once children are inside they will remain in the warm until collected at the end of the day. We will dismiss the children at home time from the main hall in a staggered way as the playground remains closed. You will need to be patient for the benefit of all children, parents and carers.

The school will be closing at 3.00pm so year groups will be dismissed from the main hall in the following order:

- 2.45 pm - Reception, Year 1 and 2;
- 2.50pm - Year 3 and 4;
- 2.55pm - Year 5 and 6.

Many thanks for your patience with the weather situation and I look forward to welcoming the children back in the morning.
