This activity could have a theme.

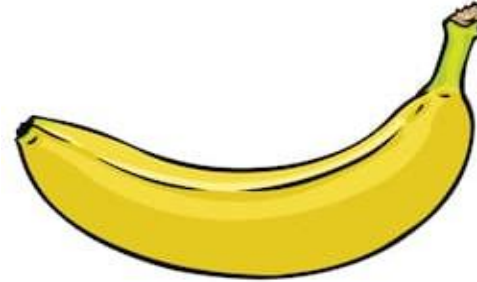
Example – Describing animals in a zoo.

I have a friend called Ron Weasley.

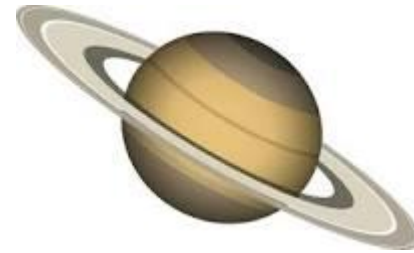


What am I?
