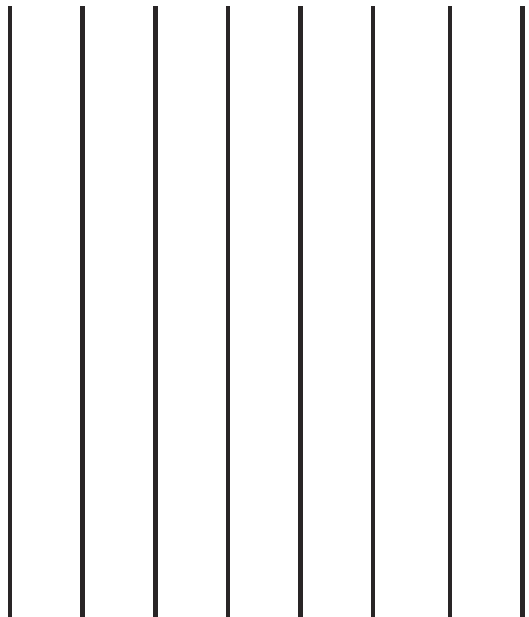
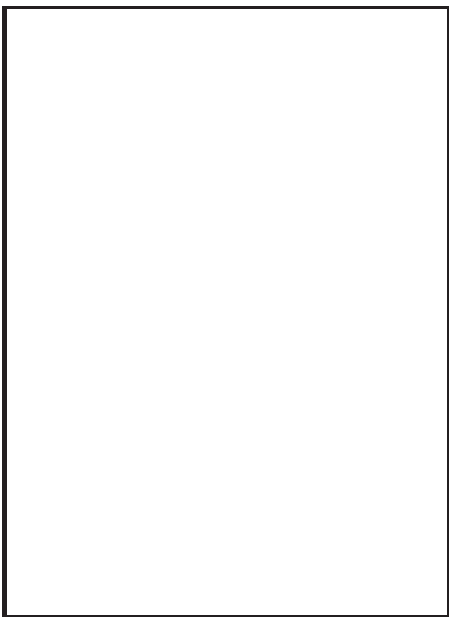
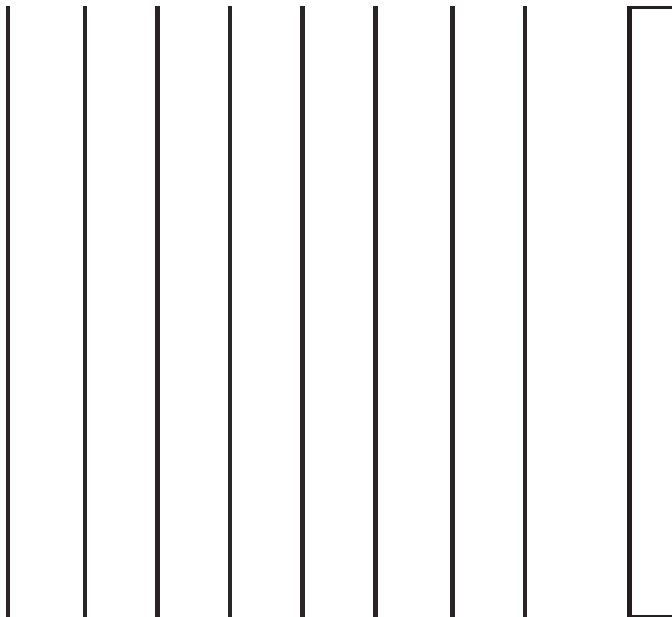
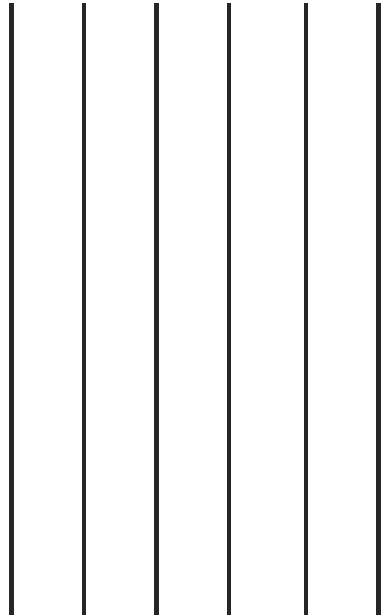
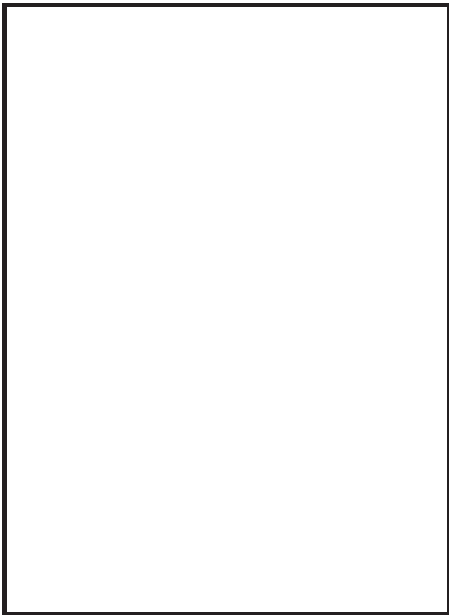
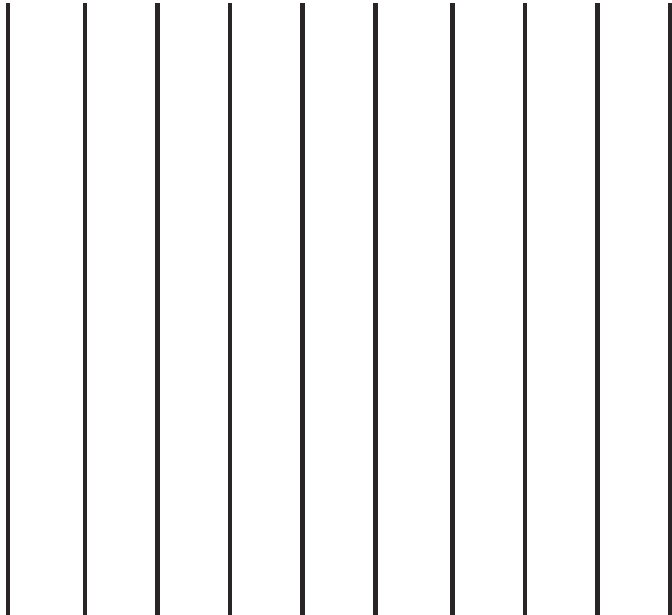
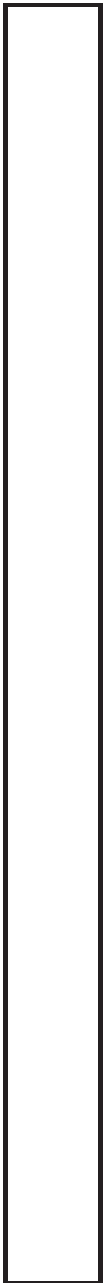
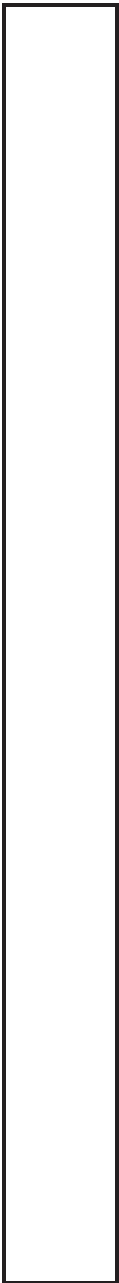
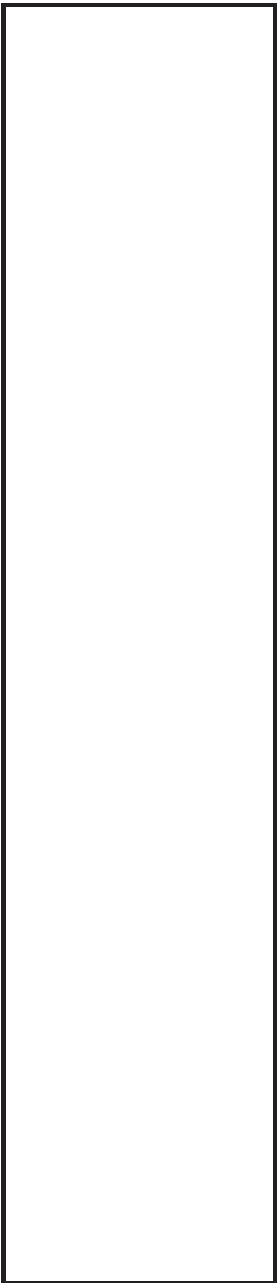
If you are writing straight into your book, don't forget the keep the newspaper format.
