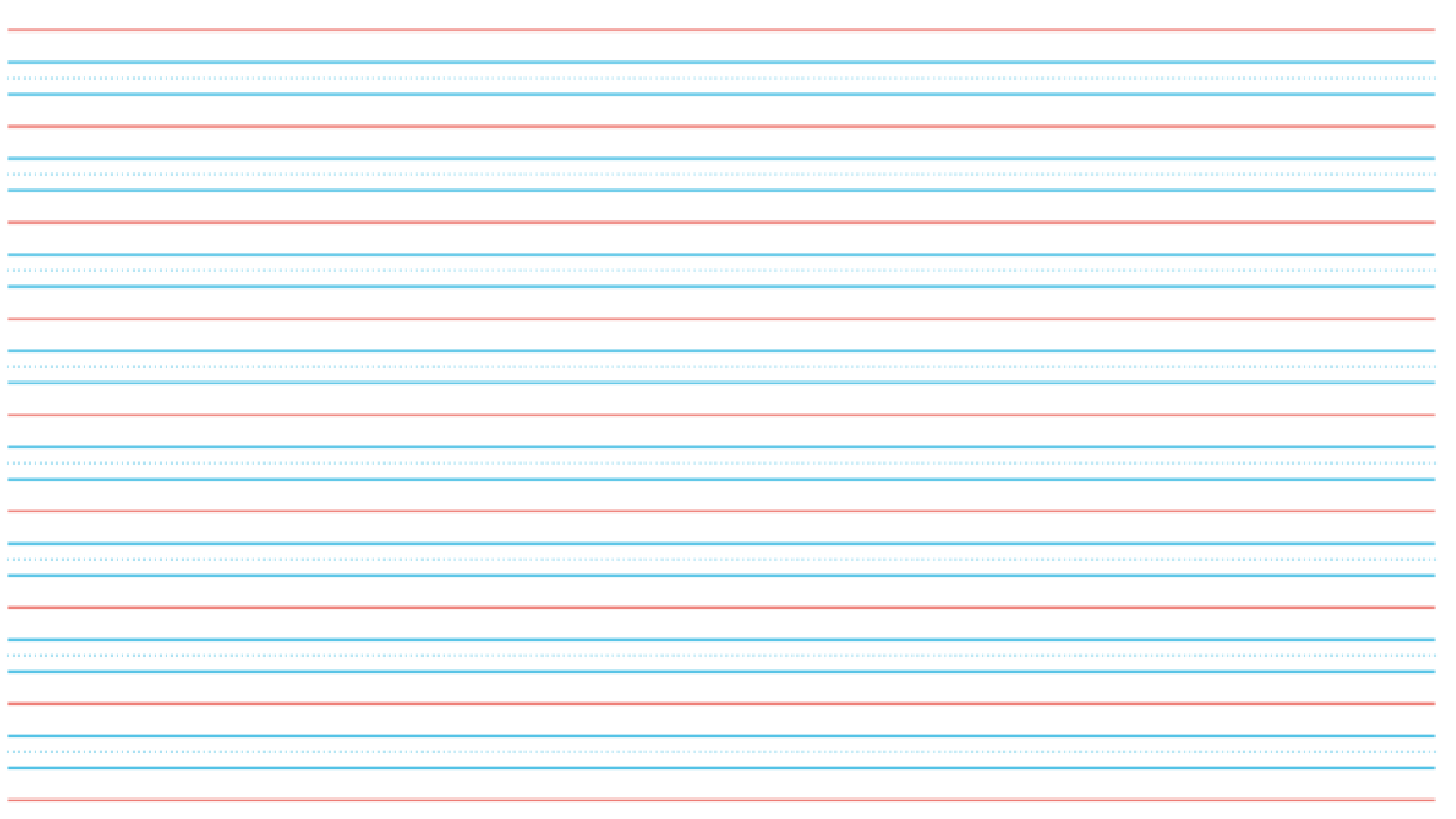

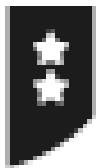

Place: *under, in, below, over, on, at, towards, down, above, across, beside, up, inside.*

Cause: *because of, due to.*
