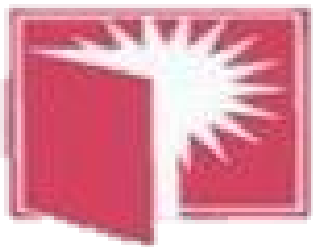
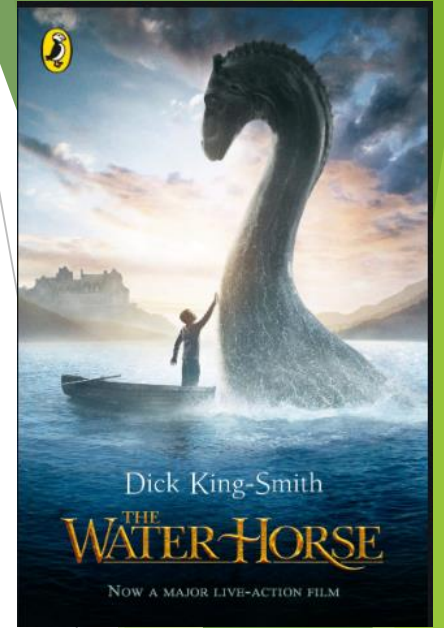

You have used capital letters and a variety of sentence starters.

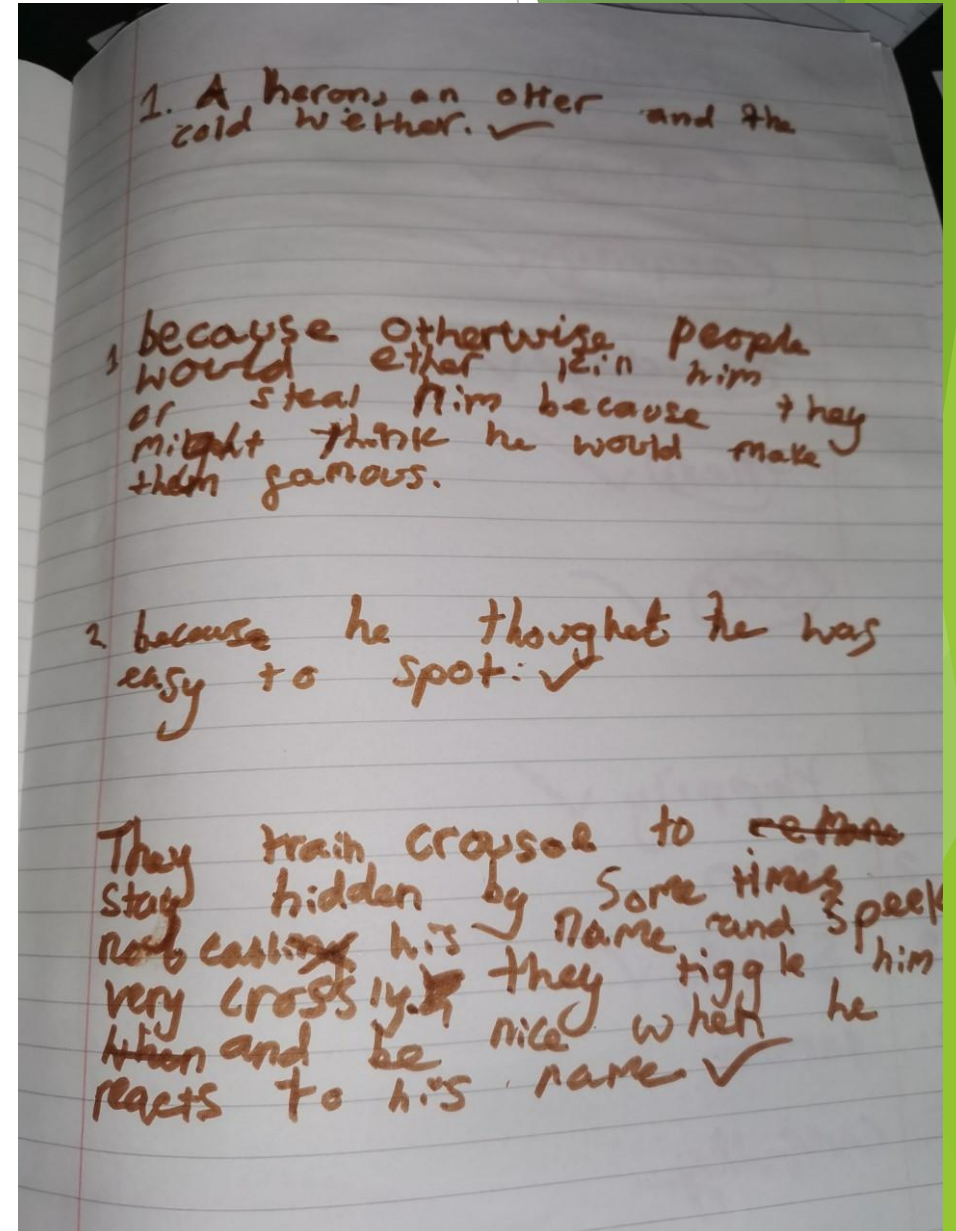
